



A Guide for Prayer Walking



“I will give you every place where you set your foot” Joshua 1:3

Why prayer walk?

Prayer is a catalyst for change. As we pray through our streets we are inviting God to come and work in our communities, reconciling all things to Him. This guide is an aid for prayer walking and gives some practical advice on:

- How to prayer walk;
- What to pray for; with a
- List of scriptures and prayer declarations

How to prayer walk

- Go in pairs, or three at the most
- As you walk, observe what is going on around you
- Ask the Holy Spirit to lead you in prayer and also your direction
- Take time stop and pray in one spot or for a particular place, house, or building as led by God
- Take the opportunity to journal what God is showing you

What to pray

- Praise God for who He is
- Pray referencing scripture – check out the listed declarations to get you started
- Pray blessings over the community
- Pray that people in the community would be drawn to God
- Pray for the people that you pass
- When natural, talk to the people that you meet. Tell them what you are doing and be open to pray for them
- Remember that we are in a spiritual battle. Ask God for His protection and to bind up the works of the enemy

Biblical declarations

Matthew 28:18-20 - *Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely, I am with you always, to the very end of the age."*

We thank you Lord that you have commissioned us to make disciples in Leighton Buzzard and beyond. We acknowledge that we are called by You and empowered by the Holy Spirit for the works that you have prepared for us in advance. Amen

John 8:12 - *When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life."*

Romans 8:1 - *Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus*

Jesus, you are the Light of the World and as we are 'in Christ' may we bring your light to the streets of Leighton Buzzard, showering our communities with faith, hope and love. Amen

Joshua 1:3 - *I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses.*

Just as you promised to give Moses every place where he set his foot, we invite You to work afresh in the area that we prayer walk. Amen

Luke 10:1-7 - *After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go. He told them, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field. Go! I am sending you out like lambs among wolves. Do not take a purse or bag or sandals; and do not greet anyone on the road. "When you enter a house, first say, 'Peace to this house.' If someone who promotes peace is there, your peace will rest on them; if not, it will return to you. Stay there, eating and drinking whatever they give you, for the worker deserves his wages. Do not move around from house to house."*

Just as you sent out the disciples in two to find 'people of peace', we ask that we might not only encounter those that need you, we also ask that we would find people of peace who would open up their networks and communities to us. Amen

Mathew 6:9-13 - *This, then, is how you should pray: "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from the evil one."*

As we stand in your covenant agreement Lord, we ask for your provision and protection over us and our families. Amen
